Task & Goals

- **Task:**
 - Competitive design & construction project
- **Goals:**
 - Communication impact on project design & implementation
 - Effects of positive & negative reinforcement

Considerations

- Exercise not entirely realistic
- Applicable to documentation projects

Roles

- Observers
- Procurement Officer
- Project Managers
- Engineers
- Workers

Task Structure

- Four project teams: Blue, Green, Red, Purple
- Each project team:
 - Observer (1)
 - Others as selected by project team
- One Procurement Officer for all project teams
- Task time: 30 minutes
- Budget: \$3,000 each project team

Expenses

- Compensation
- Construction materials
- Penalties
- Documents:
 - Egg Drop Materials Requisition
 - Egg Drop Rules
 - Egg Drop Procurement Officer
 - Egg Drop Project Team Observer
 - Egg Drop Labels

Success

- Egg doesn't break after being dropped approximately from 8 ft
- Expenses are within budget
